

**MIDWEST MOUNTAINEERING SPRING EXPO 2017**  
**CANOE KAYAK AND PADDLE BOARD AUCTION**  
**BIDDER'S INFORMATION**

1. Decide what type of canoe, kayak or paddleboard best suits your needs and skill.
2. Check in at our on-site office under the white canopy when you arrive and show your driver's license to receive a bidding number.
3. Come early so you have plenty of time to thoroughly inspect the canoes, kayaks and paddle boards that we will be selling.
4. Have several possible canoes, kayaks or paddle boards in mind to buy in case the first one you wanted happens to go for more than you wanted to pay.
5. Hold your bidding number up to bid. Don't be afraid to holler at the auctioneer in case he doesn't see your bid.
6. After your purchase, you will need to pay at our on-site office. You will receive a printed receipt that shows the purchase; the winning bid price; a 10% buyer's premium and sales tax. The buyer's premium is an amount added onto your bid to help pay for the auction services provided.
7. Also, when you pay for your purchase, we will give you a copy of the Seller's Consignment Contract that shall also be your Bill of Sale. You should bring both of these to the DMV when you register your purchase.
8. Please pay for your purchase right away since the Sellers are often present and appreciate it if we can pay them promptly.
9. Come prepared with gear to transport your purchase home. After you pay for your purchase, you may load your item. There will be volunteers from the Minnesota Rovers present to help you if needed. We will give you a ribbon to tie to the stern to indicate that your invoice has been paid. You may be asked to show your invoice to the Minnesota Rovers to show that you are the correct person to be removing the boat.
10. You can pay for your purchase with cash, a Minnesota check with a photo ID, or with a major credit card, except not American Express. If you use a credit card, a 3% convenience fee will be added to your purchase.
11. Please come prepared for an outdoor event.
